Osborne Sentenced to 20 Years for Arson

On Monday, October 7, thirty-three-year old Brian Allen Osborne, of Lafayette, was sentenced to 20 years, 100 percent, after setting a gas can on fire on the back porch of a residential home while a family of three slept inside on Sunday, April 10, 2011.

Assistant District Attorney General Justin Harris represented the State during the trial on February 7, 2013, receiving a conviction for arson, before Judge David Durham.

Macon County Sheriffs Office Deputy Kyle Petty stated that Osborne was witnessed standing over the gas can while it was on fire.

Brian Osborne is being housed in the Macon County Jail where he has been incarcerated since April of 2011.
