Merryman was educated at the University of Tennessee, while her husband, Alan Frio, majored in Communications at Temple University in his native Philadelphia.

"Alan and I didn't anchor together until we came to Nashville," Merryman said, "as a matter of fact he anchored for the competitor while I was in Philadelphia and in Los Angeles."
