

Freda Halsell Pate, age 69, of Lebanon, TN, and formerly of Red Boiling Springs, TN, passed away Monday, February 20, 2012 at the University Medical Center in Lebanon, TN. Funeral Services for Freda Halsell Pate were conducted Wednesday, February 22, 2012 at 1 p.m. from the Anderson & Son Funeral Home Chapel in Red Boiling Springs, TN with Elder Floyd Ferguson officiating. She served as the Executive Director of the Cordell Economic Opportunity Corporation in Cookeville, TN for several years and later was the former Assistance Director of the Upper Cumberland Development District.
