

Juanita Bell Burrow, of the Brattontown Community of Macon County, passed away on Saturday, August 11, 2012 at her residence at the age of 96 years. Funeral services for Juanita Burrow were conducted from the Chapel of the Anderson & Son Funeral Home in Lafayette at 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 14th with her nephew, Elder "Pee Wee" Massey officiating.
