

## **RBS Teams Drop Clay County**

The Red Boiling Springs High School Basketball game at Clay County High School scheduled for this past Friday, January 14, 2011, was the only local basketball game unaffected by the icy weather.

Travelling to face the CCHS Lady Bulldogs in regular season play, the Red Boiling Springs girls fell behind in the opening quarter 22-8, however inched closer to trail 33-24 by the halftime break.

Clay County extended their lead with 17 points in the third period, allowing RBS to pick up 15 points, CCHS 50, RBS 39.

The Red & Grey Lady Bulldogs achieved a low-six points in the final round, as Clay Co. walked away with a 67-45 win.

Layce Colter led RBS (18-3) with 13 pts., followed by Morgan Burgener with 12 pts., Heather Jenkins with nine pts., Marina Evans with five pts., and Mackenzie Painter and Katie Hix with three pts. each.

*In the boys game...* Clay County (12-5) opened the battle with a 13-6 lead, and by the halftime break, Red Boiling Springs had worked their way to trail 28-19. RBS dominated the third quarter 13-9, which produced a 37-32 shadow behind the hosting Bulldogs. In a dramatic fourth quarter, Clay Co. added 23 pts. to their lead, holding RBS down to a low-three, to claim a 60-35 win.

Wes Grace led RBS (14-6) with ten pts., followed by Allen Kirk and Isaiah Washington with six

pts., each, Jordan Grace and Andrew Mullinix with four pts. each, Shelton Watson with one 3-pt. shot, and Matt French with one pt.
