

Macon Puts Together Five Wins

MCHS Baseball play is improving as they manage to make a small run. This week they continued where they left off last week, and put together three more wins.

On Monday the 8th MCHS hosted district foe Sycamore. Sycamore scored two earned runs to take an early lead, but that is when the Tigers bats woke up. They managed to score five runs in the next two innings. After allowing two more unearned runs for Sycamore in the top of the 6th inning, MCHS scored three more runs to put the game away.
