Hayes gave the Wildcats the lead with a 3yd TD run and a 2pt conversion, 30-22. Tigers answer back with a 51 yard TD run and a 2pt play by Carlisle. Tied again 30-30. The Tigers gave up a couple of 4th qtr TD's to Bell and Hayes in a 44-30 losing effort.
